

OUR HISTORY

ROMAN FRA

1st century BC - 5th century AC

The salt mines of Remolinos were likely exploited during the Roman era, or even earlier. While data from this period is scarce, Strabo mentions the existence of rock salt mines in northern Spain, north of the Ebro River.

MIDDLE AGES 5th century - 15th century

During the Middle Ages, salt mines became prominent in legal documents due to their use as a source of income for kings and governments through taxes or monopolies. By the end of this period, the Remolinos mines were intensely exploited by the kings of the Crown of Aragon, who held the monopoly on salt supply to Zaragoza through warehouses known as "Almudíes." The main almudí was located in Remolinos, later moving to places like La Puerta de Toledo and Salinas Street in the 17th century.

RENAISSANCE 15th century - 16th century

With the advancement of the Early Modern Period, the Remolinos Salt Mines saw an increase in both production and trade. In 1564, King Philip II established an effective monopoly on the salt mines by bringing all saltworks and mines under the control of the Crown by law.

19th century

The Industrial Revolution drove the modernization of the salt industry in Remolinos. New companies were established, and improvements were made in extraction and transportation techniques. State intervention, through monopoly laws and later their repeal, marked a turning point in the history of the salt industry in Spain. The liberalization of the salt trade in 1869 led to significant changes, including the sale of state-owned mines and the beginning of private exploitation.

1889

Purasal acquired the Mina Real, making it its main operation and implementing significant technological improvements.

1901

Aerial cable carts of the "Roe" system are introduced for transporting salt from the mine to the Pedrola railway station, located on the other side of the Ebro River













1950

Purasal implements electrification and fluorescent lighting in the mine, as well as an inclined plane system with carts powered by an electric winch.

1970

During the 1970s, production saw significant growth, reaching over 100,000 tons. With the construction of a bridge over the Ebro River, the cable system was decommissioned, making way for truck-based transportation.

1989

The Mina Real, the largest in size until the 20th century, is closed after years of exploitation. Since then, all salt production has come from the "Maria del Carmen" mine.

21st century






SALT FLATS


